MOVE RULES

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. No guys in girls' dorms beyond the front lobby and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs, and weapons are absolutely prohibited.
4. Everyone must be in his or her dorm by the designated "In Dorm Time."
5. For security reasons, no students with backpacks are allowed into the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
7. During sessions, stay in your our assigned seating area. Please follow the posted seating chart.
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the speakers begin talking.
9. Respect the campus – no TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc. No practical jokes.
10. Do not move furniture. You will be charged for venue staff moving it back.
11. Do not dial 911 unless it is a true emergency.
12. Absolutely no fireworks at any time during MOVE or while on campus property.
13. No deliveries of any kind to the campus.
14. Students may leave campus ONLY with adult supervision.
15. Follow the MOVE dress code.
16. No hazing of any kind will be tolerated.
17. Phones may be collected at certain times during camp to encourage focus and a full camp experience. If a parent needs to get in contact with you or if you need to contact a parent you can use your small group leader's phone.

How much does camp cost?

Early Price (by 3/31/25): \$575

Regular price (after 3/31/25): \$625

*A non-refundable \$70 deposit is required to register and guarantee your spot.

These camps fill up fast. The earlier you can register with at least a \$70 deposit the better. Once the camp spots fill up we can only put you on a waitlist. All monies due by June 15th, or at the time of registration.

Do I have to pay for camp all at once?

No. You can pay for camp in payments.

►Must pay at least \$70 to register, but can make partial or in-full payments after that. Balance is due by June 15th.

Will there be fundraisers?

We usually do one or two group fundraisers, but this is not guaranteed. We encourage students to start raising funds on their own ASAP. Rake leaves, mow yards, bake sale, garage sale, job, etc. We have a packet of many fundraiser ideas you can do on your own, let us know if you'd like a copy of that. Here is one fun, easy idea you can start doing today :

Example Personal Fundraiser: SELL EGGS

Buy a carton of eggs. Go door to door in your neighborhood. Say, "I'm raising money for summer camp by selling eggs. One egg cost one dollar, but for two dollars you can bust the egg on my head." It's fun with friends and most people will either buy one egg or give you two dollars or more to bust an egg!

What Time and where do I drop off and pick-up?

Drop off will be at 8:30 AM on Sunday, June 29th at cfParis. We will return on Thursday, July 3rd around 10 pm. We will keep you up to date on the exact time. Students will call parents when we are 30 minutes out.

Do I need to bring spending money?

You do not have to as the camp cost includes all meals and activities. However, you may want to purchase Camp merch such as shirts, hats, hoodies, etc. Shirts cost about \$25 and hoodies cost \$40. There are several other types of swag ranging from \$2 to \$40. Sometimes MOVE allows you to pre-Purchase swag and pick up at camp, if you want to manage funds that way.

How many people stay to a room and what style are the rooms?

The dorms on campus are traditional style dorms. There will be two people per room.

Are the dorms air conditioned? Yes, the dorms are air conditioned. Our Texas heat is no joke!

What kinds of recreation options are available on campus? Rec options on campus vary depending on availability times of the Rec center and other university facilities. SFA is a beautiful campus with several bodies of water near by, MOVE staff do a wonderful job of creating fun, competitive tournaments and extra activities such as Basketball & Volleyball Tournaments, Creative art competitions and Video Game tournaments.

What are the food options available on campus? We will dine on campus at the dining hall, SFA will provide a variety of healthy and comfort options. You wont be hungry and will enjoy the college experience. As for snack options, there are a few restaurants and coffee shops throughout campus. IF you are one to get hungry at night, you should probably pack some snack for yourself.
